Greene County Public Schools (GCPS) educates approximately 2,800 children in grades PreK through 12 in one primary school (Greene County Primary), two elementary schools (Nathanael Greene and Ruckersville), one middle school (William Monroe Middle School), one high school (William Monroe High School) and one technical school (Greene County Technical Education Center). The school division student population is currently: 89% white, 9% African-American, and 2% Hispanic.

39% of the division's professional staff have a masters or doctoral degree. 98% of our professional teaching staff are considered "highly qualified," and 100% of our teachers and administrators are focused on student achievement and student success!!

Learning for all, whatever it takes!

- Ω 82% of the class of 2007 will continue their formal education after high school
- Ω William Monroe High School offers 12 Advanced Placement courses serving 126 students in 2006-2007
- Ω 85 students received dual-enrollment college credit in 2006-2007, 28 earned at least 15 college credits at WMHS
- Ω Elementary students in grades 3-5 won six out of nine team awards in area "24 Challenge" math competition (18 schools competed)
- Ω 31 new classrooms, a new gymnasium, new middle school guidance wing, and expansions to the middle school cafeteria and high school library completed prior to the 2006-2007 school year

School Safety: Discipline Data Worth Recognizing

21% decrease in the number of disciplinary referrals submitted by teachers (middle schools)

35% decrease in student disciplinary referrals submitted by teachers (high school)

64% decrease in the number of days missed as a result of out-of-school suspension (high school)

91% decrease in the number of in-school suspension days for special education students (high school)

Greene County Educational Foundation: provides scholarships for students and grants for teachers to promote innovation in the classroom.

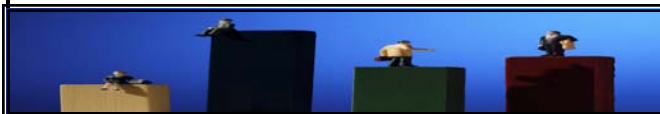

Winners of 6 out of 9 team awards in area competition

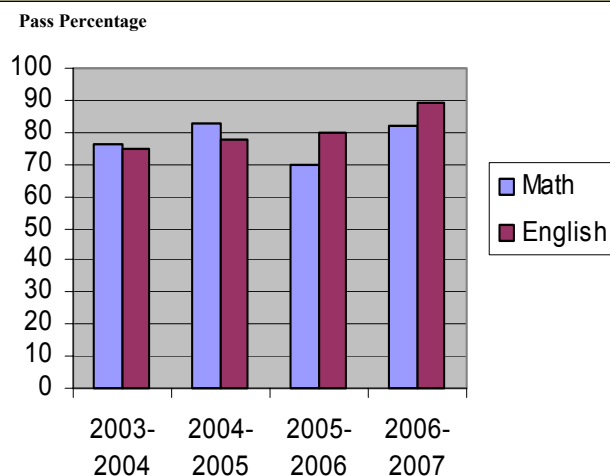


Greene County Public Schools: Vital Signs

- 1.76% dropout rate in 2005-2006 (well below the state average)
- All core area subjects and grade levels participate in a standardized benchmark assessment program
- District-wide intervention programs provided during school and/or after school
- Instructional Action Planning: action plans available on the division web-site
- 5 National Board Certified Teachers
- Standardized curriculum and pacing guides for each grade level
- 100% of the seniors enrolled as of September 1, 2006 graduated with the class of 2007!!
